Dear Parents and Carers,

Following the fantastic news that all children will return to school on Monday 8th of March, I would like to lay out arrangements in the same way I did in the autumn term.

Drop off/pick up times

To keep everyone as safe as possible we have spread out drop off and pick up times and ask for all adults to wear a face covering when on the school site. As in September, parents and carers from classes 3 and 4 must drop their children at the front gate to reduce the number of people on site. If you are late for your bubble slot, please wait until 9.15am when everyone is in school and come to the main entrance. It is really important to stick to these times and not arrive early. Please do not congregate around the school site and ensure that children are close by you and not running among other adults.

Class 3 - 8.55am

Class 2 - 9.05am

Class 1 - 9.15am

If you have more than one child, please come to the **earliest** drop off slot.

Class 4 - 3.30pm

Class 1 - 3pm

If you have more than one child at school please pick up at the **latest** pick up slot.

Breakfast and After School Club will remain open to children of essential workers only, so please consider whether you need to use this. This will be reviewed at Easter with a full opening expected after the Easter holidays if all goes well. If you do need to use these clubs please book in advance via Lunchshop.

School will operate as it did in September 2020 with the children working in class bubbles and forming two super bubbles for playtimes and lunchtimes. The same procedures for handwashing restrictions to moving around school remain in place.

We are really looking forward to welcoming everyone back to school next week. We appreciate the hard work that you have done to support home learning but the children now need to get back to some sense of normality. There will be lots for us to do but our priority is to make the full return a positive experience for everyone. On Thursday 11th March we will celebrate World Book Day. This will be a week later than the national event but is an opportunity for everyone at school to celebrate the event. Details of what we will do will follow.
